2023 PODCAST INFORMATION FORM

You are being invited to take part in a 6-episode podcast funded by GIJTR and designed to showcase the importance of a holistic, grassroots approach to transitional justice. The podcast series will feature interviews from GIJTR Consortium partners, local partners and affiliates around the world, and will be released around May-July 2023 for global distribution. Specific topics covered will include the role of conflict-related sexual violence, forensics, documentation, violence prevention, and accountability in post-conflict societies.

1. Purpose of the podcast

The podcast will be used as an introduction to the role of transitional justice in post-conflict societies for general audiences and donors. For academics, practitioners, survivors, and activists, it is intended to share lessons learned and best practices for engaging communities in truth and justice processes post-conflict.

2. Do you have to take part?

It is up to you to decide whether or not to take part. If you do decide to take part you will be given and asked to sign a consent release form. If you decide to take part you are still free to withdraw your interview *before the podcast's release* and without giving a reason. **To withdraw, please contact Camila Yanzaguano Bravo, GIJTR's Communications Associate, at: camila@sitesofconscience.org**

3. What will happen if you take part?

You will be invited to participate in an audio and/or video interview that will be recorded – and, if necessary, translated into English. You can decide which questions you want to answer and are always able to refuse to answer specific questions.

5. Will what you say in this study be kept confidential?

On the Consent Release Form, you have the option of having your name and title identified in the podcast, but you may also choose to be anonymous. It is important to note that once the podcast is released, it is available for widespread distribution and sharing. While all efforts will be made to share your interview - which will almost certainly be edited for clarity and length – with you for your approval ahead of release, please note that this review cannot be guaranteed.
