STYLE GUIDELINES

Formatting and Fonts

GIJTR uses two distinct fonts – GT Super and Graphik – in its print and online publications to project a professional image and build familiarity and recognition with its audiences. The fonts are found in the GIJTR Communications-2021 folder, and can be downloaded at home if you are working from there. While tweaks will occasionally need to be made (if a line hangs off awkwardly because the font is just slightly too big, etc.), below are the general guidelines for our typeset.

When emailing a document, it is strongly preferred that you send PDFs instead of Word documents. Most people do not have GT or Graphik fonts on their computers, which will result in the layout being distorted. If you must send a Word document via email, please substitute Graphik for: Sentence case, Black 11pt, Calibri.
